**ACTION STEP:** Set apart a journal or special way you will record the revelations you receive during the next 21 days. Let your first journal entry be one of praise and thanksgiving for God's love and faithfulness.

**Dear Beloved,**

**Vision is the bridge between where you are now and where God desires to take you.**

Vision helps you get clarity about purpose and guides you as you make decisions. It will help you press on past disappointment, difficulty, and delays so like Paul you can proclaim, "I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." (Phil 3:14)

Vision reveals the purpose of your trials. It clears the fog of your emotions to see things from God's perspective.

**JOURNAL PROMPT:** Take an inventory of obstacles, delays, and setbacks you have seen repeated in your life. Look for general themes or areas affected.

**PRAYER FOCUS:** Ask Holy Spirit to help you discern what areas you are to press through to victory and which areas He has shut a door to protect you. Thank God for both His hand of restrain and blessings.

Where there is no revelation (*vision*), the people cast off restraint; but happy is he who keeps the law. ~ Proverbs 29:18 (NKJV)

**PRAYER FOCUS:** Today spend time in prayer asking Holy Spirit to reveal the people you are called to serve. Define the part of the body that you find yourself attracted to and let God show you the field in which you will find favor.

**JOURNAL PROMPT:** Write an entry today sharing your heart for the people you are called to serve. Conclude with a prayer for this group. Consider sharing your entry with others, as the Lord leads.

**JOURNAL PROMPT:** Take an inventory of how you spend your time and resources. Do your current activities align with your current season?

**Dear Beloved,**

**Vision helps reveal the motivations of your heart.**

Godly insight allows you to join with Jesus in saying, "I can do nothing by myself, I can only do what I see the Father doing." (from John 5:19)

Holy Spirit can give you insight into why you have certain aspirations, desires, and dreams. He can show you the Father's heart in these areas.

When confronted with challenges, we often respond quickly out of our fears instead of looking first to see what the Father is doing and getting His guidance.

**PRAYER FOCUS:** Ask Holy Spirit to reveal the condition of your heart (spiritual/physical/emotional) and bring renewal. If there are broken places, receive healing. If there is weakness, receive strength.

**JOURNAL PROMPT:** Record five of your dreams, aspirations, or desires and how you've seen God moving in these areas of your life. Write down what additional spiritual guidance is needed for each.

**JOURNAL PROMPT:** Record the potential costs of the vision and affirm your "Yes" to proceed with God. Thank God for being able to supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:19)
